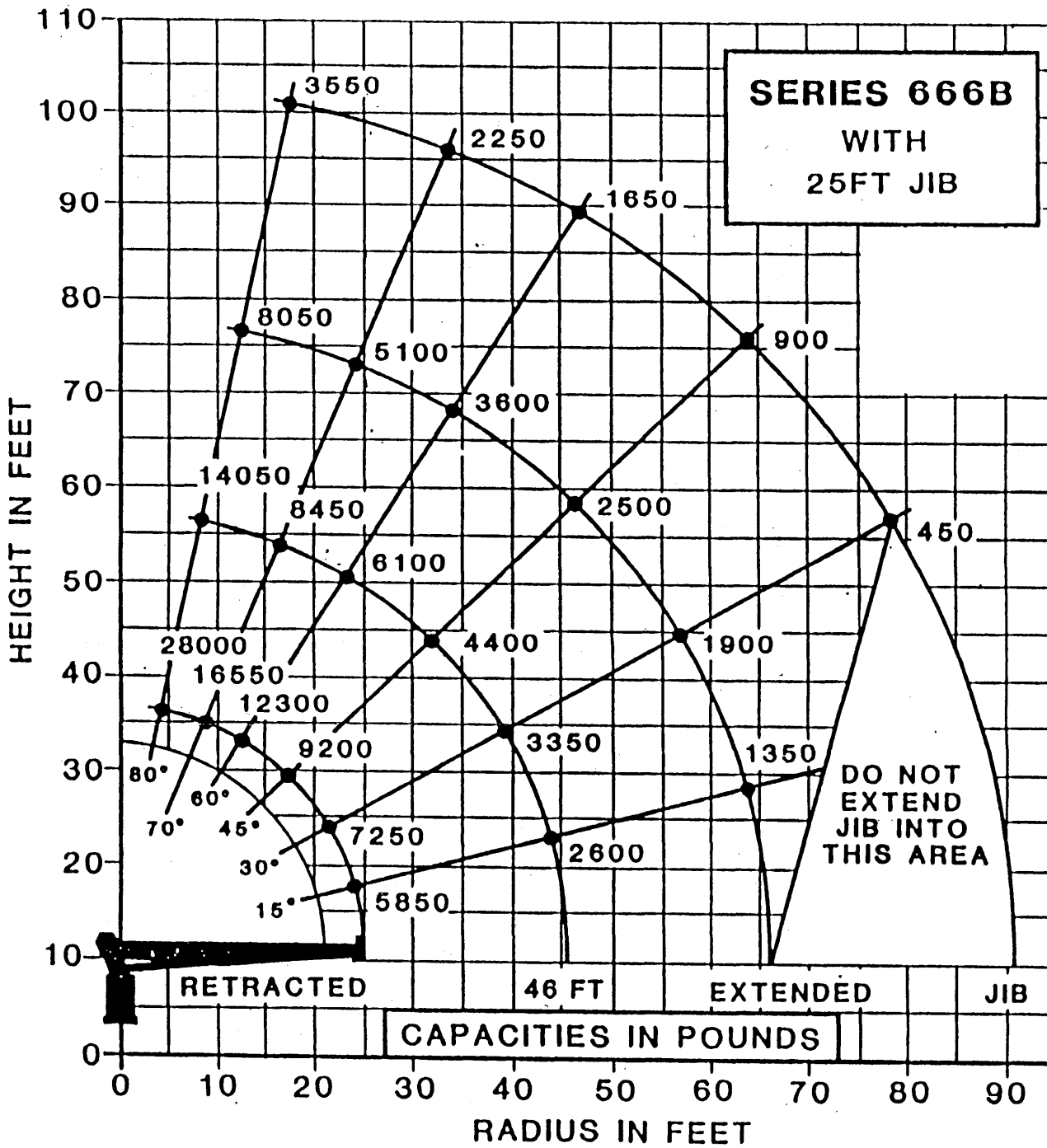


NATIONAL CRANE CORPORATION



CAUTION

1. LOAD RATINGS SHOWN ON THIS CHART ARE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE LOADS WITH THE OUTRIGGERS PROPERLY EXTENDED ON A FIRM LEVEL SURFACE AND THE CRANE LEVELED AND MOUNTED ON A FACTORY-RECOMMENDED TRUCK.
2. ALWAYS LEVEL THE CRANE WITH THE LEVEL INDICATOR LOCATED ON THE CRANE FRAME.
3. THE OPERATOR MUST REDUCE LOADS TO ALLOW FOR FACTORS SUCH AS WIND, GROUND CONDITIONS, OPERATING SPEEDS AND THE EFFECT OF FREELY SUSPENDED LOADS.
4. OVERLOADING THIS CRANE MAY CAUSE STRUCTURAL COLLAPSE OR INSTABILITY.
5. WEIGHTS OF ANY ACCESSORIES ATTACHED TO THE BOOM OR LOAD-LINE MUST BE DEDUCTED FROM THE LOAD CHART CAPACITIES.
6. DO NOT EXCEED JIB CAPACITIES AT ANY REDUCED BOOM LENGTH.
